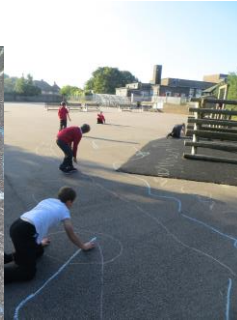

and extend language.*

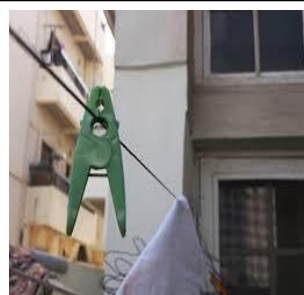
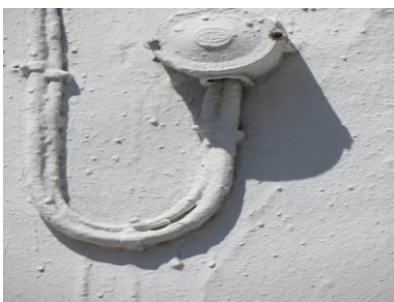
Is tiny.
